























Vocabulary for Secondary School advice sheet – additional information

Glossary of subjects that you will hear in secondary school

Subject name (and suggested colour if you are colour coding your timetable)	What is it?	Symbol
Art – <b>bright pink</b>	A lesson where you paint, draw and create different artwork	
Biology – <b>light blue</b>	A lesson where you learn about the things that live on earth including animals and plants	
Chemistry – <b>light blue</b>	A lesson where you learn about different chemicals and their properties	
Computing – <b>light green</b>	A lesson where you work on computers	
Design and Technology – DT <b>Light purple</b>	A lesson where you design and make things out of wood, metal and plastic	
Drama – <b>dark pink</b>	A lesson where you can pretend to be different people and read plays. The lesson may include acting, singing and dancing	
English – <b>dark yellow</b>	A lesson where you learn about the English Language. You will read different books and poems and write your own stories	
Food Technology – <b>dark purple</b>	A lesson where you learn about different foods and food hygiene. You will practice cooking different things	
French – <b>light yellow</b>	A lesson where you learn to read, write and speak the French language	
Geography - <b>red</b>	A lesson where you learn about the world and how people live in it	
German – <b>light yellow</b>	A lesson where you learn to read, write and speak the German language	

<b>History – light brown</b>	A lesson where you learn about the past and things that have already happened e.g. World War 1	
<b>Maths – dark green</b>	A lesson where you learn about shapes, work with numbers and use calculators	
<b>Modern Foreign Languages (MFL) – light yellow</b>	A way to talk about the different language learnt in school i.e. French, German, Spanish (see above)	
<b>Music – light pink</b>	A lesson where you learn about music. You might play different musical instruments	
<b>P.E. or Games - orange</b>	A lesson where you play different sports e.g. netball, running, football	
<b>Physics – light blue</b>	A lesson where you learn about things like electricity and different types of energy	
<b>PSHE / Citizenship /Life Skills - turquoise</b>	A lesson where you talk about health, news and your community	
<b>Registration - grey</b>	This happens every day. Your teacher will check that you are at school.	
<b>Religious Education - RE (sometimes known as Religious Studies RS) – dark brown</b>	A lesson where you learn about different religions	
<b>Science – light blue</b>	A lesson where you learn things about biology, chemistry and physics (See above)	
<b>Spanish – light yellow</b>	A lesson where you learn to read, write and speak the Spanish language	
<b>Textiles – bright purple</b>	A lesson where you learn how to sew, design and make things from material
