




































Vocabulary for Secondary School advice sheet – additional information

Glossary of words that you will hear in secondary school

Word	Definition	Symbol (all rooms are shown as squares)
Behaviour	How you are in school and whether you follow the rules. Behaviour can be good like listening well or bad like talking when the teacher is talking	
Canteen / Dining Hall	A place where you can go to eat your lunch or get a snack at break	
Community	All the people in your school are part of group or community which are there to help each other	
Computing or Information Technology (IT) room	A place that has lots of computers	
Consequence	A consequence is what happens if you don't follow the school rules	
Curriculum	What you will be taught in each lesson	
Detention	When you may have to do extra work in your lunch hour or after school if you don't follow the rules	
Dictionary	A book in alphabetical order that contains a list of words and their meanings	
Exam	When you do some work on your own to check you understand it	
Exercise book	A book that you can write and draw in	
Extra - curricular activities / After school club	Optional things that you can do before school, at lunch-time and after school e.g. football practise or book club	

Finance Office	A place you go to sort money e.g. pay for trips or sort problems with dinner money	
Form tutor	A teacher that you see every day for registration	
Gym / Sports Hall	A place where you can play sports inside	
Head of Year	A member of staff who looks after all the young people in one year group	
Homework	Work that you have to do at home	
Learning mentor	A person in school that might give you some extra help in class and outside of class	
Lesson	A time when teachers talk to you and tell you about a particular subject	
Library	A room that has lots of books. It is usually quiet. It might have some computers too	
Margin	The space that you leave at the side of the page when you write	
Medical room	A place where you can go if you are feeling unwell or need to see the school nurse	
Menu	A list of food you can look at to pick your dinner. You might pay by using your thumb or a card	
Merit	A reward for good work or good behaviour	
Period	A time when teachers talk to you and tell about a particular subject	
Planner	A book that is like a diary with the days of the week and months of the year	

Revision	When you go back through your books to make sure you can remember what you have learnt	
Science lab	A place where you may go to have a science lesson. Worktops usually have gas taps on them	
Student/Pupil	Someone who goes to school to learn	
Student Services / Student Admin	A place where you go if you have a problem, can't find your room or need help with something	
Textbook	A book that you look at to give you information about your lessons	
Timetable	A piece of paper that tells you what day your lessons are. It will also tell you what time the lesson starts, which room it's in and which teacher will take the lesson	
Underline	To draw a line under some writing, usually the title of your work	
Uniform	Clothes that everybody has to wear to school e.g. white shirt and tie or school jumper, blazer and black trousers. It can include what you have to wear for PE	
Vending machine	A machine where you can buy things such as drinks or crisps	
Verbal warning	When a teacher tells you that you have broken a rule in school so you know not to do it again	



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
