
































































## Examples of vocabulary mats and dictionaries

	<b>consequence</b>	the results of an action
	<b>restorative</b>	giving something back to someone that you have upset/harmed
	<b>expectations</b>	rules about behaviour where you are
	<b>inappropriate</b>	behaviour that most people would not like
	<b>unacceptable</b>	behaviour that should not happen
	<b>disruptive</b>	actions that stop learning
	<b>incident</b>	something that has happened
	<b>reflection</b>	thinking about what you did and why
	<b>final warning</b>	someone telling you to stop now
